

**2nd call for interested persons to join our Clubhouse Enlivening Group as well as
Weapons & History Group**

Dear Members,

Although we have now 2 persons each expressing interest to join the above captioned groups, we certainly need more to form them. If at least 3 more can come forward, it is hoped that the first meeting BOTH at our Clubhouse at 630pm would take place for the Clubhouse Enlivening Group next Wed 22nd May, and for the Weapons & History Group on Thu 6th June. Hence, I am rebroadcasting my last letter in the following.

“Further to my mentioning in our January Newsletter of the ideas proposed by our former Lt. Frank Miu now rejoining us, would those of you who are interested in the following projects which he will lead please do come forward and sign up as indicated below.

(A) Clubhouse Enlivening Group :- (1) sorting out & cataloguing the audio-visual & reading materials in the Clubhouse, as well as (2) appealing for more similar materials of interest to members (esp historic photos & videos of past RHKR parades & its activities, other videos of general interest esp military ones, information on travel & entertainment, food, medicine & health of increasing relevance to our ageing membership body),

-----for easy access by all visiting members, with a view to encouraging greater utilization by members of our Clubhouse (which is certainly worth tens of thousand dollars each month in rental value) through : (a) enabling the self-help and/or limited-help enjoyment of those by such members, and (b) looking into the possibility of reviving periodical Movie Nights plus adding possibly Karaoke Nights (as well as perhaps self-help karaoke and/or movie viewing too, provided of course that the Jockey Club has no objection to any plan of ours which must ensure no nuisance to others including our own other visitors) °

(B) Weaponry & History Group :- On the basis of the mostly airsoft replicas of 30 classic modern personal firearms of the past 180 years (since the invention of revolvers in 1836), now on permanent display in the Clubhouse (on the wall racks in the far right recessed corner facing the racecourse),

-----to study all relevant aspects including the origin & history of those & other

weaponry items (which, when extended to gunpowder's, would take one back by about 1,000 years into the history of empires in the East & West), and which study is believed to be something that may be as interesting, if not more so, as the study & collection of artcrafts such as paintings & porcelain (while most of those classic personal firearm replicas of ours are also artcrafts in themselves) that some retirees and young enthusiasts tend to focus on.
