Parking for Clubhouse Members and Associate Members

During normal opening hours of the Clubhouse, all Members of the Association (including Clubhouse Members and Associate Members) with valid membership are welcome to use the Clubhouse facilities (with their guests, if any) for attending events organized by the Association, squadron gatherings, horse races or self-arranged private functions. Parking for Members (and their guests) in HKJC's Infield Carpark free of charge may normally be arranged through the Clubhouse Manager with prior notice to HKJC and subject to carpark space availability. Members however should note that Infield parking is primarily intended for HKJC Members. It is only a compliment service provided to the Association for the convenience of Members and guests visiting the Clubhouse and on a need-basis. Members are reminded to strictly observe the following conditions for using such parking service:

Conditions for Using HKJC Infield Parking by RHKRVA Members/Associate Members and their Guests

- No parking is allowed on Happy Valley horse racing days/evenings.
- No overnight parking is permitted.
- Carpark operating hours are from 1200-2200 hours daily and no prolonged parking beyond the mentioned hours is permitted save in very exceptional circumstances (e.g. RHKRV Foundation Day Dinner) and with prior consent from HKJC.
- Infield parking is provided to only Members with valid Association membership (and their guests, if any) subject to prior notification, space availability and on 'first-come first-served' basis. Members are reminded to bring their Association membership card when using such service as HKJC security guards have the authority to inspect the membership card to establish the identity of the driver.
- HKJC requires the Association to pre-register with their Control Room the licence plate number of the cars using such parking service. As such, Members should provide the Clubhouse Manager with such information **normally at least 24 hours in advance** through email clubmanager@rhkr.org or telephone call 2966 7895 or any appropriate social media to the Clubhouse Manager.
- In exceptional cases when urgent parking is needed, at least 2 hours' advance notice is required for the Clubhouse Manager to make special arrangement with HKJC. However, Members are reminded that parking in such circumstances is subject to HKJC's approval and is **NOT GUARANTEED**. Last minute request to the Clubhouse Manager for making parking arrangement will normally not be entertained as the Clubhouse Manager may be engaged in off-site work or other urgent duties. HKJC has every right to refuse entry and turn away any car which has not been pre-registered with their Control Room.

- Parking arrangement can only be made for each visit separately. Block reservation of parking for one or more vehicles for an extended period (e.g. every Tuesday evening for a quarter/year) will not be accepted by HKJC. It is also not possible to give HKJC a list of Members' vehicles which will use the Infield Carpark during a specified period.
- To avoid omissions and to reduce workload for all parties involved, the coordinator of a function (e.g. the Member responsible for coordinating the attendance of a squadron event/gathering) is encouraged to provide a consolidated list of the car licence plate numbers of the Members and guests attending the event/gathering to the Clubhouse Manager in advance to facilitate smooth arrangement.

Members should note that it is the Association's intention to maintain a smooth and cooperative working relationship with HKJC continuously in order to safeguard the harmonious relationship between the two parties and the widest interests of all Members. The Board of Directors of the Association takes very serious views on any Members (or their guests) who misbehave themselves or who act indiscriminately resulting in damage to the Association's harmonious relationship with HKJC. The Board of Directors will consider ceasing to arrange parking for individual Members who have misbehaved themselves. In the most extreme case, the Board of Directors will consider terminating the membership of the misbehaved Members concerned. Members are therefore requested to note and comply with the above conditions strictly when using HKJC's Infield parking service.
